Mittens

Sizes	0-2 (2-6) 6-12 months
Circumference	12 (14) 16 cm / 4,7 (5,5) 6,3"
Length	7 (8) 8,5 / 2,8 (3,1) 3,3"
Yarn	Imagine Soft Merino
Amount of yarn	50 g / colour
Gauge	22 sts = 10 cm / 4"
Needles	4 mm (US6) cable needle for Magic loop 3,5 mm (US4) for rib
Notions	Tapestry needle

Glossery

{ }	Repeat
K	Knit
P	Purl
K2tog	Knit two together
SSK	Slip, slip, knit
St/s	Stitch/es
Rnd/s	Round/s

Info

Cute mittens to keep the small hands warm. Perfect for mixing the colours just the way you want.

Knitted from the top down. The ribbing is folded double to make them stay at your babys hands better. The pattern is written for Magic loop but you can of course use double pointed needles if you prefer them.

Directions

Cast on 30 (34) 38 sts on needle 3,5 mm (US4) with colour 1.

Rib: {k1, p1} with colour changes as below:

Colour changes:

4 rnds of Colour 1
2 rnds of Colour 2
4 rnds of Colour 1
2 rnds of Colour 2

Keep on knitting rib with Colour 1 until the work measures 9 (10) 10 cm / 3,5 (4) 4".

Change to needle 4 mm (US6) and to Colour 2.

Knit in the round until the mitten measures 4 (4,5) 4,5 cm / 1,6 (1,8) 1,8" from where the rib ends.

Decreases

Rnd 1: k1, k2tog, k until you have 3 sts left on needle 1, ssk, k1.

Repeat on needle 2.

Rnd 2: Knit

Repeat Rnd 1 and 2 until you have 10 sts left.

Next rnd: {k2tog} to the end

Break the yarn and pull through the last 5 sts.

Weave in all loose ends. The ribbing is folded double so make sure you weave in the ends at the right side.

Knit the second mitten the same way.
