

# IMAGINE

## Throw

<b>Sizes</b>	One Size Width: Approx. 68 cm / 26,8" Length: Approx. 80 cm / 31,5"
<b>Yarn</b>	Imagine Soft Merino. 350G
<b>Gauge</b>	19 sts x 28 row = 10x10 cm /4x4"
<b>Needles</b>	4,5 mm (US7) cable needle 75 cm / 30".
<b>Notions</b>	4 stitch markers, scissors, tapestry needle.



### **Glossery**

<b>{ }</b>	Repeat
<b>K</b>	Knit
<b>P</b>	Purl
<b>RS</b>	Right side
<b>WS</b>	Wrong side
<b>M</b>	Marker
<b>PM</b>	Place marker
<b>SM</b>	Slip marker
<b>St/s</b>	Stitch/es

### **Info**

This throw is knitted back and forth. It is a simple throw with only knit- and purl stitches making beautiful details.

### **Moss stitches**

Row 1: {k1, p1} to the end.

Row 2: knit over purl sts and purl over knit sts.

### **Stockinette stitches**

RS: knit

WS: purl

### **Structure knitting**

RS: {k4, p1} to the end.

WS: {p4, k1} to the end.

## Directions

Cast on 131 sts on needle 4,5 mm (US7).

**Next 16 rows:** Moss stitches

**Row 17 (RS):** 10 sts of Moss sts, PM, stockinette sts to 10 sts left, PM, Moss sts to the end.

**Row 18-31:** moss sts to M, SM, stockinette sts to M, SM, moss sts to the end.

**Row 32 (WS):** moss sts to M, SM, p10 (stockinette sts), PM, k to 20 sts left, PM, p to M (stockinette sts), moss sts to end.

## Structure pattern

**RS:** Moss sts to M, SM, stockinette sts to M, SM, p1, {k4, p1} to M, SM, stockinette sts to M, SM, moss sts to end.

**WS:** Moss sts to M, SM, stockinette sts to M, SM, k1, {p4, k1} to M, SM, stockinette sts to M, SM, moss sts to end.

Knit structure pattern until the work measures 65 cm / 25,6". Do the last row at the RS.

Repeat row 32 but remove the M showing where the structure pattern begins and ends.

Repeat row 18-31.

Repeat row 17 but remove M instead of placing.

Next 16 rows: Moss stitches

Bind off loosely.

Weave in all loose ends and block your throw.

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
