Beanie

Sizes	0-2 (2-6) 6-12 (12-24) months
Circumference	32 (35) 38 (41) cm / 12,6 (13,8) 15 (16,1)"
Length	15 (17) 18 (19) cm / 5,9 (6,7) 7,1 (7,5)"
Yarn	Imagine Soft Merino or Soft Merino Thin
Amount of yarn	50 g / colour
Gauge	26 sts = 10 cm / 4" in stockinette sts in Soft Merino Thin 22sts = 10 cm / 4" in stockinette sts in Soft Merino
Needles	<u>Soft Merino Thin</u> : 3,5 mm (US4) cable needle for magic loop or dubble pointed needles, 3 mm (US2,5) for rib. <u>Soft Merino</u> : 4 mm (US6) cable needle for magic loop or dubble pointed needles, 3,5 mm (US4) for rib.
Notions	4 stitch markers, tapestry needle

K2tog	Knit two together
SSK	Slip, slip, knit
St/s	Stitch/es
Rnd/s	Round/s
M	Marker
PM	Place marker

Info

Knit this adorable beanie with your choice of Soft Merino for cozy warmth or

Soft Merino Thin for lighter comfort.

Were the pattern differ it says (Thin) or (Soft) in brackets.

This beanie is knitted from the rib to the top. You can use both magic loop or dubble pointed needles.

The ribbing is folded dubble.

Directions

(Thin) Cast on 72 (80) 88 (96) sts on needle 3 mm (US2,5) in Colour 1.

(Soft) Cast on 60 (68) 72 (80) sts on needle 3,5 mm (US4) in Colour 1.

PM to mark beginning of round. Join in the round and knit rib.

Rib: {k1, p1} with colour changes as below:

Colour changes:

4 rnds of Colour 1

2 rnds of Colour 2

4 rnds of Colour 1

2 rnds of Colour 2

Continue work rib with Colour 1 until the work measures 9 cm / 3,5".

Change to needle (Thin) 3,5 mm (US4). (Soft) 4 mm (US6) and to Colour 2.

Knit stockinette sts until the beanie measures

(Thin) 8 (9) 10 (11) cm / 3,1 (3,5) 4 (4,3)".

(Soft) 9 (10) 11 (12) cm / 3,5 (4) 4,3 (4,7)"

measured from where the rib ends.

Decreases

PM with (Thin) 18 (20) 22 (24) sts apart, (Soft) 15 (17) 18 (20) sts apart.

You now have 4 markers together with the marker that shows beginning of round.

Rnd 1: {k til 2 sts before M, k2tog, SM, ssk} to end of rnd.

Rnd 2: knit

Repeat Rnd 1 and 2 (Thin) 6 (7) 8 (9) times total, (Soft) 5 (6) 6 (7) times total.

You now have (Thin) 24 (24) 24 (24)

(Soft) 20 (20) 24 (20) sts on your needles

Next rnd: {k2tog} to the end. Remove M.

Break the yarn and pull through the remaining sts.

Weave in all loose ends. Have in mind that the ribbing is folded double so be sure to weave in the ends on the right side.

Do a pompom in Colour 1 and attach on the top of the beanie.
